

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A KIDS RECREATION TRUST FUND GRANT APPLICATION FOR EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,250.00 AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS IF AWARDED GRANT

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Chosen Freeholders has announced the "Kids Recreation Trust" Grant; AND

WHEREAS, this grant program has been designed to fund three types of recreational opportunities, Scholarship, Equipment, and Recreational Improvements; AND

WHEREAS, the total amount of \$23,250.00 which will be applied by the Division of Parks & Recreation for the equipment component of the grant which requires a dollar-to-dollar match; AND

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield – Division of Parks & Recreation will apply for \$20,000.00 and the match will be available from the Recreation's budget – Other Equipment line item #0-01-28-370-001-267, Recreation Materials #0-01-28-370-001-261 and Uniform & Equipment #0-01-28-370-001-238 as evidenced by the A/City Finance Officers Certificate. The Plainfield Pop Warner Cardinals will apply for \$2,500.00 and their match will be available from their operation budget with Garden State Community Bank – Acct. #1008940300 as evidenced by the treasure of the Organization and finally the Plainfield Soccer Club will apply for \$750.00 and their match will be available from their operation budget with Investors Savings Bank – Acct. #06-612897 as evidenced by the Chief Financial Officer of the Organization attached hereto; NOW

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Plainfield that the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to submit the attached grant application for the Kids Recreation Trust Fund - Equipment Grant to the Union County Office of the Open Space, Recreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund and if awarded accept funds from the Open Space, Recreation and Historic Preservation; BE IT


FURTHER RESOLVED, that a duly executed copy of this resolution and Grant Application be filed in the Office of the City clerk.
