

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LIEN PLACEMENT FOR THE CLEAN-UP OF  
THREE (3) PROPERTIES TOTALING \$1,800.60 AS PER THE ATTACHED  
SCHEDULE "A"**

**WHEREAS**, on or about July 28, 2009 through August 3, 2009, emergency abatement requests were issued for three (3) properties requiring corrective action in the form of cutting overgrown grass and weeds, inclusive of the curb area to bring said properties in compliance with the Property Maintenance Code; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 4.12 of the Property Maintenance Code of the City of Plainfield and N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.13 et. seq., the Public Officer took the necessary action to correct violations existing at said properties which constituted a hazard and blighting influence; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Officer engaged the City of Plainfield, Division of Public Works to accomplish the necessary work, inasmuch as they were able to do so with the least possible delay and has certified the costs thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the necessary monies for payment of the costs incurred will be charged against the Department of Public Works Budget Line Item 3.22, as evidenced by the City's Finance Officer attached hereto; Now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Plainfield, that in accordance with Section 4.12 of the Property Maintenance Code and N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.14, hereby authorize the placement of liens in the aggregate amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and 60/100 (\$1,800.60) as set forth in Schedule "A" attached hereto, and that the respective owner(s) of record be duly notified of said lien(s);


