

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF
JAMES MANGIN AS THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of P.L. 1988, c. 110 (N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.10) requires that the governing body of every municipality appoints a Chief Financial Officer who holds a Municipal Finance Officer Certificate issued pursuant to the provisions of P.L. 1971 c. 413(N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.1); and

WHEREAS, James Mangin, holds a Municipal Finance Officer's Certificate and has the requisite experience; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A:9-140.10 provides that the term of office shall be four years, which shall run from January 1st in the year in which the Chief Financial Officer is appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Plainfield that James Mangin, be appointed as the Chief Financial Officer with a four year term of office, as per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-140.10, commencing on January 1st in the year in which he is appointed and expiring on December 31, 2012;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield does hereby grant a waiver of the residency requirements set forth in Chapter 11, Personnel, Article 19:11-1, et. seq. to James Mangin.
