

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING BRINKERHOFF ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES, INC. TO CONDUCT ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AS RELATED TO USEPA BROWNFIELD PETROLEUM ASSESSMENT GRANT AT THE AT THE CITY OWNED LOT LOCATED AT 165-169 NORTH AVENUE; BLOCK 313, LOT 14

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield had prepared a Request for Qualifications and selected 7 consultants to be pre-qualified for all environmental work for USEPA and State of New Jersey Brownfield Grants; and

WHEREAS, Brinkerhoff Environmental Services, Inc. is located at 1913 Atlantic Avenue, Suite R5, Manasquan, New Jersey 08736 and is one of the pre-qualified environmental firms as accepted by the Plainfield City Council as per Resolution R361-08 dated August 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield has previously retained the services of Brinkerhoff Environmental Services Inc. to conduct the Preliminary Assessment (PA) and the Site Investigation (SI) environmental services at the city owned lot located at 165-169 North Avenue; Block 313, Lot 14 within the City; and

WHEREAS, Brinkerhoff Environmental Services, Inc. has submitted a cost proposal dated April 23, 2009 indicating they will provide a Remedial Investigation (RI) environmental services at the cost not to exceed \$11,242.00 which is to be paid directly from the existing USEPA Petroleum Assessment Grant; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available through G-02-41-791-306-432, as evidenced by the annexed certification of the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Plainfield;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield does hereby authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a contract to retain the services of Brinkerhoff Environmental Services Inc. to conduct an environmental Remedial Investigation (RI) at 165-169 North Avenue (Block 313, Lot 14) in the City of Plainfield for an amount not to exceed \$11,242.00, all of which shall be paid directly from the existing USEPA Petroleum Assessment Grant; be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
