

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING HATCH MOTT MACDONALD TO
CONDUCT ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AS RELATED TO THE
USEPA BROWNFIELD HAZARDOUS ASSESSMENT GRANT AT THE
PLAINFIELD BILINGUAL DAY CARE CENTER/225-231 WEST SECOND
STREET; BLOCK 245, LOT 1**

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield had prepared a Request for Qualifications and selected 7 consultants to be pre-qualified for all environmental work for USEPA and State of New Jersey Brownfield Grants; and

WHEREAS, Hatch Mott Macdonald located at 27 Bleeker Street, Milburn, New Jersey 07041-1008 is one of the pre-qualified environmental firms as accepted by the Plainfield City Council as per Resolution R361-08 dated August 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield has previously retained the services of Hatch Mott Macdonald to conduct the Preliminary Assessment (PA) environmental services at the Plainfield Bilingual Day Care Center/225-231 West Second Street; Block 245, Lot 1 within the City; and

WHEREAS, Hatch Mott Macdonald has submitted a cost proposal dated April 2, 2009 indicating they will provide the required Site Investigation (SI) at a cost not to exceed \$52,550.00 and an Initial Ground Water Investigation not to exceed \$9,550.00 to be charged on a time and material basis for a total not to exceed \$62,100.00 which is to be paid directly from the existing USEPA Hazardous Assessment Grant; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available through G-02-41-791-206-432, as evidenced by the annexed certification of the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Plainfield;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield does hereby authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a contract to retain the services of Hatch Mott MacDonald to conduct an environmental Site Investigation (SI) and an Initial Ground Water Investigation (GWI) at the Plainfield Bilingual Day Care Center, 225-231 West Second Street (Block 245, Lot 1) in the City of Plainfield for an amount not to exceed \$52,550.00, for the SI and \$9,550.00 for the GWI, for a total aggregate amount of \$62,100.00, all of which shall be paid directly from the existing USEPA Hazardous Assessment Grant; be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
