

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CME/ICON ENGINEERING TO
CONDUCT ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES AS RELATED TO USEPA
BROWNFIELD HAZARDOUS ASSESSMENT GRANT AT REDEMPTION
POWER/212-218 LEE PLACE; BLOCK 120, LOT 3.01**

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield had prepared a Request for Qualifications and selected 7 consultants to be pre-qualified for all environmental work for USEPA and State of New Jersey Brownfield Grants; and

WHEREAS, CME/ICON Engineering is one of the pre-qualified environmental firms as accepted by the Plainfield City Council as per Resolution R361-08 dated August 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield has previously retained the services of CME/ICON Engineering to conduct environmental services at Redemption Power/212-218 Lee Place; Block 120, Lot 3.01 within the City; and

WHEREAS, CME/ICON Engineering has submitted a revised cost proposal dated January 6, 2009 indicating they will provide additional Remedial Investigation (RI) environmental services at the cost not to exceed \$21,740.00 which is to be paid directly from the existing USEPA Hazardous Assessment Grant; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available through G-02-41-791-206-432, as evidenced by the annexed certification of the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Plainfield; Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield, hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to hire CME/ICON Engineering; be it,
