A RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION WITH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY IN A SAFE AND SECURE COMMUNITIES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE, DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the **Plainfield Police Division** wishes to apply for a project under the Safe and Secure Communities Program (Grant # P-4626); and

WHEREAS, the **City of Plainfield** has been determined to be eligible to reapply for \$58,045 in continuation salary funding for two Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Plainfield** will be responsible for the remaining salary balance and fringe benefits costs in the amount of \$155,720; and

WHEREAS, salary and fringe benefit funding for this project for \$155,720 are available in the FY2009 Budget Code, as evidenced by the City's Finance Officer's Certificate attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the **City of Plainfield Police Division** wishes to reapply for funding for a project under the **Safe and Secure Communities Program, Grant No. P-4626**; and

WHEREAS, the **City Council of the City of Plainfield** has reviewed the application and has approved said request; and

WHEREAS, the project is a joint effort between the Department of Law and Public Safety and the **Plainfield Police Division**, for the purpose described in the application;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the **City Council of the City of Plainfield** that

- 1) As a matter of public policy the **Plainfield Police Division** wishes to participate to fullest extent possible with the Department of Law and Public Safety.
- 2) The Attorney General of New Jersey will receive funds on behalf of the applicant.
- 3) The Division of Criminal Justice shall be responsible for the receipt and review of the applications for said funds.
- 4) The Division of Criminal Justice shall initiate allocations to each applicant as authorized by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to file the grant renewal application for \$58,045 for the **Safe and Secure Communities Program** and to provide any additional information and execute such documents as may be required to accept the grant funds for this program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a duly executed copy of this Resolution will be filed in the Office of the City Clerk.
