

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE IN THE
CONTRACT AWARD AMOUNT TO THE EXISTING
NON-FAIR AND OPEN CONTRACT TO
BROWNFIELDS REDEVELOPMENT SOLUTIONS, INC. (BRS)
FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE
US ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (USEPA)
BROWNFIELDS PETROLEUM ASSESSMENT GRANT**

WHEREAS, the City of Plainfield has retained the services of BRS, Inc. to serve as the Brownfield Consultant to provide for the management and administration of the USEPA Brownfields Petroleum Assessment Grant as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 19:44A- 20.5*; and

WHEREAS, the original contract amount was certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will not exceed \$9,080 for a period of one (1) year beginning November 1, 2008 and terminating October 31, 2009, and may not be without further authorization of the City Council of the City of Plainfield; and

WHEREAS, due to the increased number of Petroleum Brownfield Sites identified/selected for study by the ten (10) member Brownfields Committee and the increase in the administrative and management time required for each new site location; and

WHEREAS, BRS, Inc. has submitted a revised cost proposal dated January 26, 2009 indicating they will provide the additional management and administration of the USEPA Brownfields Petroleum Assessment Grant with Leah Yasenchak PP, AICP as representative for the additional cost of \$20,000.00 of which is paid directly from the existing grant with no taxpayer participation; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding is available through G-02-41-791-306-432, as evidenced by the annexed certification of the Chief Financial Officer of the City of Plainfield; Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Plainfield, hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to increase the cost cap of the existing contract with BRS, Inc. from \$9080.00 to \$29,080.00 as described herein; be it,


FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution be attached to the existing contract and be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
