

**Resolution Authorizing Maintenance Agreement for Proprietary  
Computer Software with Queues Enforth Development for the  
Public Safety Computer Center**

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Computer Center of the Plainfield Fire and Police Divisions has solicited an agreement with Queues Enforth Development, a computer software support company, to renew maintenance of the Public Safety Computer Center Software at the Police and Fire Divisions for the sum not to exceed \$23,268.00 from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the maintenance agreement to renew the Maintenance Agreement; for 2007-2008 was approved by City Council for the City of Plainfield by Resolution R-240-08; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Division recommends the purchase of software maintenance for its current systems; and

**WHEREAS**, Queues Enforth Development, 14 Summer Street, Malden, MA 02148 is the sole provider and vendor providing proprietary computer software maintenance for the current software in the Public Safety Computer Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the provision of goods and services to local contracting units for the support of proprietary computer software is an authorized exception to public bidding requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1) et. seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, this maintenance will be in the best interests of the City of Plainfield in that it will enable the Public Safety Computer Center to continue providing for critical and essential Fire, Police and Emergency Medical Services; and

**WHEREAS**, there is sufficient funding for this purchase in an amount not to exceed \$23,268.00 from Budget Code 9-01-25-240-004-228; as evidenced by the City Finance Officer Certification attached hereto; Now Therefore Be It

**RESOLVED**, By the City Council of the City of Plainfield that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to issue a purchase requisition to Queues Enforth Development for the renewal of maintenance agreement for the proprietary computer software in an amount not to exceed \$23,268.00, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a duly executed copy of this resolution be filed in the Office of the City Clerk.
