

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 2, ADMINISTRATION, ARTICLE 2, CITY
COUNCIL

BE IT ENACTED, by the Council of the City of Plainfield, New Jersey, that Chapter 2, Administration, Article 2, City Council, Section 2:2-9 (a), be and is hereby amended as follows:

The Council shall convene in regular meetings on the first and third [Wednesday] **Monday** of every month other than June, July, August and November, at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers - Municipal Court **or such other place as may be established by resolution and public notice.** During the months of June, July, August and November, the Council shall convene in regular meetings on the third [Wednesday] **Monday**, at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers - Municipal Court, except that when a regular meeting day falls on a legal holiday the meeting shall be held the same hour and place on the next day which is not a legal holiday, unless the Council shall otherwise provide by resolution. In preparation for the regular council meetings herein described, the Council shall convene in agenda/work meetings on the preceding Monday of each regular meeting irrespective of the month in which it falls and which agenda/work meeting shall be convened at the City Hall Library or such other place as may be established by resolution and public notice.

Section 2.

The various parts, section and clauses of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable so that if any part, sentence, paragraph, section or clause is declared invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall be published in the City's official newspaper in the manner required by law.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, twenty (20) days following action or inaction by the Mayor as provided by law or on override of a mayoral veto by the Council, whichever is applicable in accordance with law, unless a resolution is adopted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:69a-181(b) declaring an emergency and providing that this ordinance shall take effect at an earlier date.
