

Sec. 2:2-3. President of Council.

The Council shall elect a President of the Council from among its members at its organization meeting.

(A.C. 1969, 2.1(b))

Sec. 2:2-4. Duties of President of Council.

The President of Council shall:

(a) Preside at Council meetings;

(b) Appoint all Committees of the Council, except no Committees may be appointed for administrative purposes;

(c) Approve vouchers chargeable to appropriations (limited to personal expenditures by Council members), provided that each such voucher has been listed on a Council agenda and the Council has taken no contrary action at its next regular meeting;

(d) Approve vouchers chargeable to the City Council account for stationery, clerical help or the like, which need not be listed on the Council agenda; and,

(e) Have such other duties as the Council may prescribe by resolution.

Sec. 2:2-5. Council as committee of the whole; Chairman.

(a) The Council may act as a committee of the whole.

(b) The Council shall elect a Chairman of such committee from among its members to serve for a term of one (1) year and until the election and qualification of his successor.

(A.C. 1969, 2.1(c))

Sec. 2:2-6. Disqualification of Councilman.

In the exercise of the Council's power to judge the election and qualification of its members under Section 2.12 of the Charter, the following rules and standards will be applied:

(a) Any question as to the election or qualification of newly elected members, for cause occurring prior to the commencement of a term will be considered only upon written challenge filed with the Council on or before
