Dear Honorable Council Members:

The Plainfield Special Improvement District (SID) Board of Directors requests your permission for our Holidays 2007 promotion.

The promotion will involve two major components:

- 1) the display of 110 holiday wreaths and snowflakes on PSE&G utility poles throughout downtown and South Avenue. Appropriate notification has been made to PSE&G and liability insurance certificates which add the City of Plainfield, Plainfield SID, and PSE&G as insureds have been submitted to the City Administration and PSE&G.
- 2) The third annual Plainfield SID "Holiday Horse & Wagon Rides" on Saturday, December 8. Due to popular demand, we again plan to sponsor two wagon rides through downtown and South Avenue during that afternoon, which will entail the escort of a police patrol car, with a staging area in the municipal Plainwood Square Park on South Avenue (McDonalds on W. Front Street in the downtown). Hot chocolate, treats, Santa, and carolers and other holiday favorites are also anticipated.
- 3) We also request that adequate walking police patrols be assigned daily throughout the Plainfield SID during the holiday season which begins on November 23 and ends on January 2, 2008.

Funding for the promotion and decorations will be paid entirely from the Plainfield SID tax assessment on commercial properties in our district. Thank you for your anticipated reply and for your support of the Plainfield Special Improvement District.
